At Ward Pound Ridge Reservation

In the Saddle 12:00 Noon, back at the trailers about 3:00PM

Come join us for a nice trail ride after Turkey Day or strike out on your own. You don't have to worry about hunters, since there is no Hunting in the Reservation. Ward Pound Ridge Reservation is a Westchester County Park featuring 4,700 acres with 35 miles of trails which are easy to moderate riding.

Recommended that your horse has shoes/boots & bring water for your horse as the park is dry.

Directions:

Route 84 to Route 684 South

South on Rt. 684 about 13 miles Exit Rt. 35, Katonah, NY

Make a left at traffic light and go East on Rt. 35 for 4 miles to Rt. 121.

Make a right turn on Rt. 121, park entrance on left. (about 75')

Continue straight to Park Office. Continue straight, up hill, look for parking Area on left.

There is a \$10.00 charge for parking. Have your Coggins Test.
